My favourite verse is Job 19:25,  
**"I know that My Redeemer liveth."**

There are a certain number of verses in scripture, which are a favourite of mine, but this one is my most favourite.

The first time I heard it was when I was listening to Handel's "Messiah". I had heard a lot about this classical piece of music, but all I really knew about it was the Hallelujah Chorus. In

fact, almost all of it is scripture verse and passages set to music and I would encourage all of you to listen to it at least once – from beginning to end. When I heard the words, the hairs at the back of my neck stood up. I think mainly because of the fantastic truth that God is in charge.

There are times for all of us, when the circumstances of life seem so dire that we don't know which way to turn or what to do. At times like these, Job Chapter 19 verse 25 is a real strength. Whatever our circumstances, know that God is bigger than them.

It was Job who spoke these words at the point of his life when he had lost everything he held dear – family, possessions, position. He was then "comforted" by his "friends" who basically said – you must have done something really bad for God to punish you like this.

Job's reply was, "I know that my Redeemer lives and one day will stand upon the earth."

Read the verse for yourself and let God speak to you through it.
