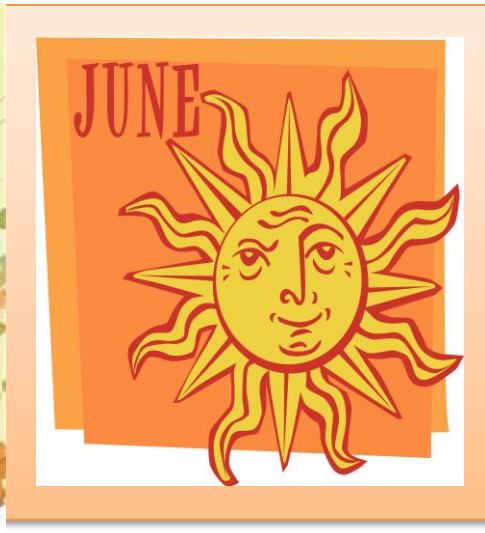


C.C.F. UPDATE

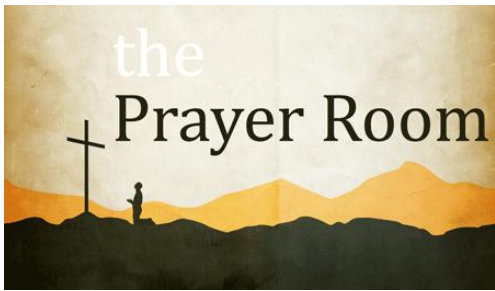

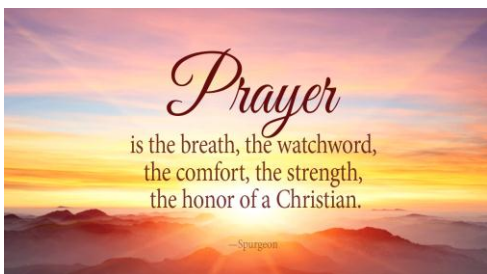
