


## TBN UK



## Lessons at Jesus' Feet

Have you ever found yourself making conclusions about some things only to realize that you've made a mistake? I have! I have made judgments on people's characters simply on the basis of their appearance and have realized that I have made tremendous errors in doing so. Although they say that first impressions always count – first impressions can also be misleading.

This reminds me of the classic story of the two Jewish givers – one was a rich man and the other a poor widow. The former gave from his abundance while the other gave her all in her poverty.

How can we tell how people are truly like?  
In 1 Samuel 16:7, we read,

***“The LORD doesn't see things the way you see them. People judge by outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart.”***

I heard a few weeks ago about a little girl who was so embarrassed to be seen with her mum because the mother was all covered in scars and her face was slightly deformed. One night as the mother was tucking her to bed, the little girl asked “Mama – why is your face not pretty? The mother tenderly explained “ You see when you were a baby, our house caught on fire and I had to save you from burning – guess I'd rather it was me who got burned than you. The little girl traced her mother's face with her tiny hands and whispered -- “the other children say my mother looks like a witch.....” Her mum took her tiny hands and placed them against her tiny chest then quietly said...what does your heart say dear? With tears in her eyes, the little girl crawled out of bed and gave her mummy a great big hug. .... ***Some things are not what they seem.***

I believe that it is a good practice to keep looking beyond appearances and beyond just the veneer. For when we do -- we can be surprised to find countless treasures and precious truths concealed behind them - - we may even find God!
