



Workshop on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Cornerstone held a Workshop on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit during the Joint House Group meeting in January aimed at finding out which of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit do the members of Cornerstone have and which of the current ministries in place people are interested in getting involved in.

The workshop also provided participants with an opportunity to discuss the different barriers people have in using their gifts to build the body of Christ. These barriers will now be addressed in the different House Groups so that ever one can be encouraged to discover their gifts, explore and test them.

Moving forward, folks with same gifts will be organized into groups for a time of prayer after Sunday Services - seeking the Holy Spirit for guidance, on-going development and practice of the gifts with the encouragement that each person continues to pray throughout the week returning with any word/scripture received. We are also looking into having the monthly mid-week services spear-headed by these different groupings. Those who are already in ministry should be encouraged to pray for guidance as to gifts being used to best effect. (Luke 11:9) . So, watch this space!
