Deuteronomy 11:18-21 says: ⁸ "So commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these words of mine. Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders. ¹⁹ Teach them to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up. ²⁰ Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, ²¹ so that as long as the sky remains above the earth, you and your children may flourish in the land the LORD swore to give your ancestors."

Over the last 7 years we have also raised almost £3000 for charity. Our biggest event was last year's "Turn On The Tap" project which raised £1000.

Also pray for our Future Plans. We need to move to a larger room as there are 5 children moving up from Crèche this year.

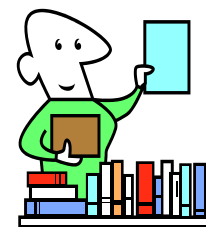
Finally, please uphold both the leaders and children in prayer, and prayerfully consider if you are being called to assist in this ministry.

Centre had a number of book donations during the past month including the Westminster Confession of Faith, a range of children's book items and some Christian themed DVDs worth checking out.

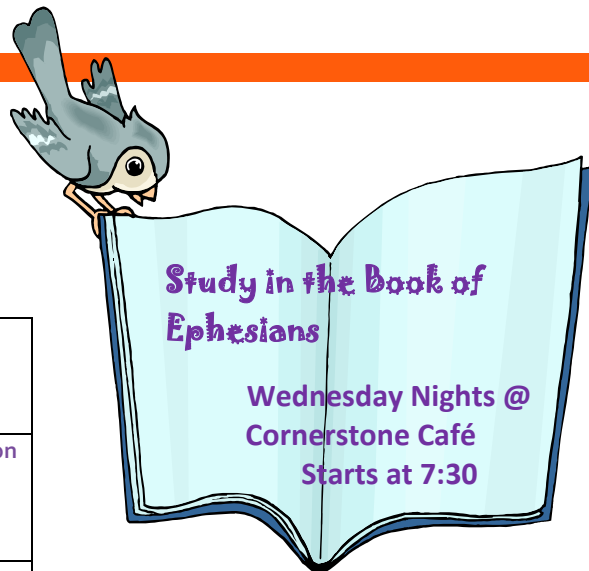
We had a Library Forum presenting a story time for Children of all ages of the Velveteen Rabbit on Saturday 27th July. The Forum facilitates informal study groups looking at

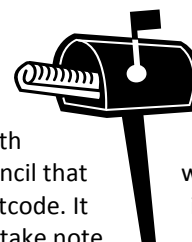
