Lessons from Cherish Conference 2018

Recently I attended the Cherish Conference in Leeds with Teri and Davina. We had a fabulous weekend of great teaching and good fellowship. One of the speakers was Louie Giglio. I hadn’t heard him speak before and I was keen to hear what message he brought for us. One message in particular had a big impact on me. He spoke about how God invites us to his table to feast with Him. However, sometimes we allow the enemy to sit at the table with us! He recalled sending a long text to one of his friends, full of issues and difficulties he was facing. His friend replied with only 9 words: **Do Not Let The Enemy Sit At Your Table!** Louie went on to share with us that there were 4 ways of knowing that the enemy was at your table:

1. If you hear that its ‘better at the other table’, then the enemy is at your table. Your place at God’s table is the very best place for you!
2. If you hear that ‘you’re not going to make it’, then the enemy is at your table. However, you **can/will** make it because you’re sitting at the table with the Shepherd. God makes it possible.
3. If you hear that you’re not good enough, not smart enough, or you have a low self-esteem, then the enemy is at your table. You are **always** good enough for God. He values you, He made you the way He made you!
4. If you hear that people ‘dislike you’ or are gossiping about you, then the enemy is at your table. Satan prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour – but God’s got you surrounded!

God changed history for You! You are prized by Royalty and you are invited to His banqueting table. Tell yourself – the enemy can prowl around all he likes, but he will NOT sit down at my table!
