## Small Grants 'PB' Fund – Round 1

Deadline for applications: Monday 16th March 2020

- ◆ This initiative is part of Cornerstone's new **Cumbernauld CAN Project** ('CAN' = Community Anchor Network) helping local people meet local needs
- ◆ The Scottish Government has contracted with Cornerstone House Centre to apply this approach and provide funding support for a range of small local projects.
- ◆ Community-led voluntary groups in Cumbernauld are invited to bid for a small grant of between £50 to £500 under the Participatory Budgeting model
- ◆ Participatory Budgeting ('PB') is a democratic way of involving local people in deciding what is needed for their community



**Get involved in the Community 'Kist' Grant - apply and make a difference to existing local activities or attend decision meetings.**

- ◆ The application process is simple. Decisions will be made during a community event in late March where local people will vote on the bids received
